

Brake Repair Tips

The first indicator that you will need to take your car in for brake repair is an unusual noise when braking. An occasional noise is to be expected from time to time of course, but when it happens on a regular basis, you may have to bring your car in to have an expert perform brake repair. Below are some of the common signs that your car may be due for brake repair.

Squealing

If you often hear a noise from the vicinity of your cars brakes even when you are not braking, the most common cause is worn brake pads. Such an occurrence warrants taking your car in for an immediate inspection of the braking system. If you hear a louder squeal than usual whenever you apply the brakes, your brake linings have probably crystallized, and their function is possibly impaired. This is also a situation that warrants a full brake inspection as early as possible.

Grinding

When you hear a grinding sound from your brakes when you hit them or even when you are simply driving, there is likely a serious problem with your brakes or with your wheels. Your car may have worn brake linings, or there may be problems with your wheels bearings. Since either of these scenarios may cause a total failure of your brakes or wheels, expert brake repair help is strongly advised.

Brake pedal floored Of course this problem will render your brakes quite useless, so you should obviously get expert brake repair help immediately.

There are many causes for such a problem, and it will definitely not solve itself no matter what the cause is. Your only alternative is to have your brakes inspected thoroughly by an expert, and have a proper repair procedure performed. You may have to call for a tow truck if your brakes stop working totally. Under no circumstances should you continue to drive your car if the brakes fail to work!

Brake light stays on If your brakes red light comes on AND stays on, you should get expert brake repair immediately. Your brakes may seem like they are working normally even with the light on, but there is a risk that they can fail at a moments notice. If you feel that your brakes arent functioning normally, you should probably call for a tow truck.

Regardless of what kind of trouble you are having with your brakes, it is important to seek qualified and professional help. Properly functioning braking systems are essential for your safety, and you should only rely on an expert for brake repair.
